The City of Lutsk represented by the Capital Construction Department of the Lutsk City Council is planning to announce competitive tendering for the works, goods and services defined by the Project "Energy Efficiency in Public Buildings in Lutsk City". The start of tenders took place in the fourth quarter of 2018. The continuation of the tender announcement is scheduled until June 13, 2020

The City intends to use the funds from a loan provided by Nordic Environment Finance Corporation (NEFCO), funding from the city of Lutsk and grant funds from Eastern Europe Energy Efficiency and Environment Partnership (E5P)* for the works, goods and services as listed below.

The Projects is being implemented based on the decision No. 34/2 of the Lutsk City Council dated 29 November 2017 "On attracting a loan and grant from NEFCO for financing the Project "Energy Efficiency in Public Buildings in Lutsk City ".

Within the framework of the project "Energy Efficiency in Public Buildings in Lutsk City", in 2018-2019 contractors will be selected for implementation of contracts in a total amount of about 7.3 million Euro in the following areas:

- thermal modernization of public buildings;
- partial replacement of windows and entrance doors;
- partial replacement of cooking stoves;
- indoor lightning;

- reconstruction of heating systems;
- partial replacement of network pipes;
- installation of individual heating substations with automated control and pipe insulation;
- improvement of ventilation systems.
