Project: Thorough repair of the street lighting networks in Melitopol city in the way of technical re-equipment with LED-fixtures

Capital Construction Department of the Melitopol City Council of Zaporizhia region hereinafter referred to as "the Employer", intends to use part of the proceeds of a loan and grant from the Nordic Environment Finance Corporation (NEFCO) towards the (cost) of "Thorough repair of the street lighting networks in Melitopol city in the way of technical re-equipment with LED-fixtures"

The Employer now invites the Contractors to submit their tenders for the following contract to be funded by the loan and grant, aimed at purchase of the materials and related work:

Lot 1: Loan-financed Plant&Related Works

"Supply and installation of equipment needed to replace existing fixtures with new LEDs, replacement of metal brackets, reinforced concrete pillar supports, suspension of the SIW wire using fittings to suspension, disposal of dismantled lamps and dismantling of all obsolete electrical equipment".

Lot 2: Grant-financed Plant

"Equipment needed to replace existing fixtures with new LEDs".

Tenders are invited for both lots – tenders for one lot only will be rejected. Each lot must be priced separately. Plant supplied under Lot 2 will be exempt from taxes.

To be qualified for the award of a Contract, Tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

- the Tenderer, has the financial, technical and production capability and capacity necessary to perform the Contract, and Tenderer's average annual revenue in the previous **three** years was at least **two** times greater than price of his tender. In case of tender submitted by JVCA, the leading partner should demonstrate at least 50% compliance with the requirement;
- the Tenderer has satisfactorily delivered similar plant and works to other Employers and completed at least **five** (5) similar Contracts in the recent **five** years;
- the Tenderer or its agent will be able to carry out warranty obligations;
- the Tenderer is not bankrupt or under bankruptcy procedures according to the national legislation or regulations:
- in the case of a Tenderer offering to deliver plant under the Contract which the Tenderer does not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Tenderer has been duly authorised by the plant's manufacturer or producer to deliver the plants in the Employer's country.

In preparation of their offers, the Tenderer should take into account that the works in this Contract will tentatively start on **February 20120** and continue to **June 2020**.

Tender documents, upon request from prospective Tenderer, will be sent by email free of charge in electronic format (PDF file). If requested to send documents in the written form, the documents will be sent by Employer to Tenderer on terms and conditions agreed by the two.

All Tenders must be accompanied by a Tender security in the form of tender-securing declaration whose form is provided in Tender Document. The purpose of Tender security is to ensure the Tenderers are serious about their participation.

The winning tenderer will have to provide performance security from a reputable bank acceptable to NEFCO.

Tenders must be delivered to the office at the address below before 11:00 a.m., 10.12.2019, at which time they will be opened in the presence of those Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend.
