European Union has provided grant funds to rehabilitate war damaged district heating and water and wastewater infrastructure in the following communities in Ukraine: Borschahivka, Borodyanka, Irpin, Slavutych, Dymer, Ivankiv, Nemishayeve, Dmytrivka, Hostomel, Kalynivka, Piskivka and Velyka Dymerka located in Kyiv region, Ukraine. Together with respective utilities the communities are planning to announce competitive tendering for the works, goods and services defined and financed under the EU Programme "Repair of critical infrastructure, Ukraine"*.

The project will include repair of critical district heating and water supply systems, pumping stations and treatment plants due to the damage caused by the Russian invasion. It is expected that approximately 45 million Euro will be spent to finance several contracts of various size (mostly under 1 million Euro but some up to 3 million Euro) starting in the second quarter of 2023. Works are expected to be completed during 2024.
