

Towards a green transformation in Chernivtsi

The project “Energy efficiency improvements in public buildings in the city of Chernivtsi” helps create energy security and support Ukraine’s energy independence.

It encompassed capital renovation and energy efficiency modernisation of Chernivtsi social facilities previously affected by heat loss with support from Sweden and the Eastern Europe Energy Efficiency and Environment Partnership (E5P).

The implemented measures included two main groups: the thermal modernisation of building envelopes and heating system replacement.

Timeline

33 public buildings were renovated from 2018 to early 2022.

An additional grant enabled the reconstruction of one more school, set for completion in 2024.

Impact

- Benefiting **17,800 children** and serving **42,000 IDPs**
- Renovated medical facilities serving **23,000 people**
- **39% primary energy savings** in the modernised buildings
- Annual municipal budget savings of **EUR 1.7 million**

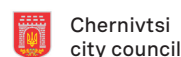
