Kropyvnytskyi City Council is going to announce competitive tendering for the works, goods and services required for the Project “Sustainable Water Supply Modernization in Kropyvnytskyi Municipality” (the Project).

The Project aims to rehabilitate and modernize the existing water supply system serving the Nove urban settlement in order to ensure stable, energy efficient, and resilient provision of drinking water.

To implement the Project, the Kropyvnytskyi City Council intends to use grant funds provided by Norway and administered by NEFCO, as well as its own funds as co-financing. The total budget of the Project is expected to be approximately EUR 378,000 (excluding VAT).

The Project is being implemented based on the Grant Agreement between Kropyvnytskyi City Council and NEFCO dated 09 February 2026.

Main Project Components:

- **Component 1 – Replacement of the pumping equipment and installation of frequency regulators at the 2nd water booster station**

- **Component 2 – Energy and water management systems with new power and water meters at the 2nd water booster station**
- **Component 3 – Interconnection with the central water supply system of Kropyvnytskyi.**
- **Component 4 – Construction of a 40-kW solar photovoltaic plant to meet the power needs of the 2nd water booster station**

Final technical solutions, equipment specifications, and the detailed scope of work are determined in the approved design and estimate documentation.

In general, the Project involves the supply of equipment and materials; the execution of related works (installation, etc.) and services by contractors; commissioning of the completed works.

Open tenders for the selection of contractors are anticipated to be announced in the second quarter of 2026, and the Project is expected to be fully completed by or in September 2027.
